1. DECLARATION BY APPLICANT

The principle of mutual recognition is that any person holding a current occupational licence or registration in one state/territory or New Zealand is entitled to a comparable licence or registration in another state/territory or New Zealand.

A person who lodges a notice for registration under the mutual recognition legislation pending the grant or refusal of registration, taken to be registered. Such registration is called 'deemed registration'. Deemed registration in one state/territory or New Zealand does not of itself provide a basis for registration in another state/territory or New Zealand.

Registration under mutual recognition includes the licensing, approval, admission, certification (including by way of practising certificates), or any other form of authorisation, of a person required by or under legislation for carrying on an occupation.

(v) My registration in any state/territory or New Zealand is not cancelled or currently suspended as a result of disciplinary action
(vi) I am not otherwise personally prohibited from carrying out the occupation/s for which registration is sought in any state/territory or New Zealand and am not subject to any special conditions in carrying out that occupation, as a result of criminal, civil or disciplinary proceedings in any state/territory or New Zealand
(vii) I give consent to the making in inquiries of, and the exchange of information with, the Authorities of any state/territory or New Zealand regarding my activities in the occupation/s for which registration is sought or otherwise regarding matters relevant to this notice.

And I make this solemn declaration, as to the aforesaid, according to the law in this behalf and subject to the punishment by law provided for any wilfully false statement in any such declaration.
